Silver Valley High School and the Alternative Education Center both received a six-year accreditation, the highest level, from the Western Association of Schools and Colleges this past spring! This process assures parents that the school is a trustworthy institution for student learning. The process involves the schools doing a self-study that involves all stakeholders giving input to develop a school-wide action plan on student learning and address areas for improvement. A trained team of administrators from other school districts then come and speak with students, parents, teachers, site and district administration. This team then makes a recommendation for accreditation with WASC giving a final decision and timeline for review. Both sites will have a two-day, on-site review in three years, which is typical, to check on their progress towards meeting their goals.

We are proud of our high schools and the hard work and effort their teams put into getting this six-year accreditation so we may continue providing a high-quality education to our students and continue to have the highest graduation rate in all San Bernardino county!

We are happy to announce that all school sites

in Silver Valley will be a little brighter this year! In partnership with Schneider Electric, we will be installing over 7,500 new LED lights throughout the district, including Colin Powell Preschool! All classrooms will have new LED lights, making the classroom brighter and improving the learning environment. Also, new LED lights will be installed on the exterior of all buildings, making campuses brighter and safer at night for staff. The Alternative Education Center and Yermo School also received new lighting and ceilings in their multipurpose rooms. With the switch to LED lighting, the district will experience significant savings in its energy bills for years to come!

Also, we have been able to do some much needed heating and air-conditioning (HVAC) work throughout the district. Lewis Elementary School will be getting OVER 40 new HVAC units and two evaporative coolers as well! We were also able to improve the HVAC units in the A and B wings at the high school. With the new HVAC units will also come an updated, centralized control system. This allows the district to keep a better eye on maintaining comfortable temperatures for our



classrooms and alerts us to any problems that need to be addressed right away. And, just like the lighting, this will allow the district to experience greater savings in our energy bills for years to come.
